

Rail Fence Pizzazz Quilt

In just two contrasting colors, this rail fence quilt pattern has a stunning geometric pattern.

Finished quilt size: 45" by 67". Pattern adapted from a free AccuQuilt pattern found on favquilts.com.

General instructions:

1. Review all information provided with the kit. Before beginning, match the fabric pieces included with the kit instructions.
2. Quilts need to be machine quilted or hand quilted. Quilting can be plain in-the-ditch or as elaborate as you wish to quilt it. Tied quilts do not have the durability for multiple washings, and we ask you not to secure your quilt by that method.
3. If you need assistance in order to complete the quilt, please contact one of the committee members. This program strives to accomplish two goals: It helps us provide quilts to the many worthwhile groups/agencies we serve, and we aim to assist novice quilters to learn basic quilting skills in the process.
4. Remember, a ¼" seam allowance is used for all seams.

MATERIALS:

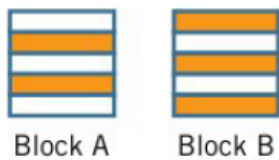
- 2-1/4 yards fabric for dark strips and binding
- 1-3/4 yards fabric for light strips
- 2-3/4 yards backing fabric

Cutting:

- Cut 27 strips 2" wide by width of fabric from light fabric
- Cut 28 strips 2" wide by width of fabric from dark fabric
- Cut 6 strips 2.5" wide by width of fabric from dark fabric for binding

SEWING DIRECTIONS:

1. Make 24 Block A and 30 Block B.



2. Layout five fabric strips in chosen color order.
3. Make five strip sets for Block A and six strip sets for Block B.
4. Pin and sew strips right sides together.
5. Press seams toward dark fabric.
6. Measure width of strip set (approx. 8").
7. Cut five squares to this measurement across pieced unit.
8. Layout blocks according to diagram.
9. Pin and sew horizontal rows together.
10. Press seams of each row in opposite directions toward vertical stripes.
11. Pin and sew rows together to complete quilt top.
12. Press seams toward bottom of quilt.

Quilt Assembly:

Prepare backing, sandwich with batting, quilt as desired.

Bind the quilt using the enclosed directions.

Attach the enclosed label.
